

World Alzheimer Report 2019 Global survey on attitudes to dementia

Have your say and take part in Alzheimer's Disease International's largest global survey to date on attitudes around dementia.

Take a moment to complete the 10 minute survey, which has been tailored to four different groups - people with dementia, care partners, the general public and health and care professionals.

Dementia will affect nearly 80% of New Zealanders at some point in our lives, but almost half of us report that we feel we know little about it.

Globally, 40% of people with dementia report not being included in everyday life. The research being undertaken in the survey is crucial to help us broaden understanding and acceptance of dementia and dispel some of the stigma and misunderstandings associated with the condition.
